Objective: Encourage Significant Housing Development

- Strategies
 - Explore a broad range of housing options and intensification to attract and retain younger demographic/families, and to encourage diversity and sustainability in the community
 - Implement zoning changes to facilitate and support an increase in density, use, and types of housing options
 - Engage with vacant and underutilized property owners zoned for residential use to understand their intentions for future development
 - Create and distribute a development opportunities package to prospective residential builders
 - Facilitate communications to build opportunities between property owners and developers
 - Expand infrastructure to support growth by taking advantage of programs and initiatives for funding

Objective: Support Business Retention and Growth

- Strategies
 - Promote a supportive business friendly environment that retains, grows, and diversifies our economy
 - Elicit strategic advice and feedback from an Economic Development Committee consisting of key businesses and organizations to develop resources and programs valuable to our commercial and industrial sectors
 - Provide access to information and resources to local businesses on subject matters that are of relevance and importance to their prosperity
 - Invest the funds necessary to support Community Improvement Plan applications

Objective: Facilitate a Thriving Downtown

- Strategies
 - Attract people to the area through a variety of venues, amenities, and events that promote return visits
 - Promote the mixed-use model of commercial on the ground floor and residential units above
 - Complete a downtown beautification study and work plan to showcase the RiverWalk District as a unique place to enjoy
 - Devote the resources necessary to make physical improvements throughout the Downtown based on the beautification study
 - Work collaboratively with the Business Improvement Area to enhance the viability, sustainability, and growth of the RiverWalk District

Objective: Mobilize Youth and Public Engagement


- Strategies

 - Secure strategic recommendations through a Community Recreation
 Committee to identify recreational opportunities for all generations
 - Foster partnerships that allow youth to access higher education opportunities close to home

- Encourage innovative programs and technologies through all emergency service partners
- Provide residents with strategies to reduce their personal risk through simple safety measures

Objective: Maximize Waterfront Use

- Strategies
 - Maintain public access to the waterfront as a unique feature found here in the Town of Prescott
 - Develop engaging opportunities that complement the natural environment of the waterfront
 - Attract water-based experiential activities to the waterfront
 - Promote the St. Lawrence River as an amenity which is accessible to all
 - Research and implement waterfront protection strategies in response to the effects of climate change
