ALL ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY AND CLEAN

FIBRE AND PAPER

All boxboard must be broken down; that which does not fit in the recycling container must be bundled.

- Boxboard (cereal, tissue boxes, liner removed)
- Calendars, glossy flyers, posters
- Cardboard, cardboard tubes
- Clean paper shopping bags or paper packaging

YARD WASTE

The town accepts grass clippings, sods, plant remains, wood chippings, branches under 6" wide, brush and leaves in paper bags only.
