2024-2025 WASTE CALENDAR

- Garbage collection occurs every Tuesday at 7:00 a.m.
- Attach one garbage tag to the top of each garbage bag
- Bag size should not exceed 90L (32.5" x 30") with a maximum weight of 44lbs per bag
- Recycling collection occurs every Thursday at 7:00 a.m. (fiber/paper and mixed containers on alternating weeks)
- Yard waste (leaves, branches and grass) collection occurs on the last Wednesday of every month from April November at 7:00 a.m. Paper bags accepted only.

LIST OF ACCEPTED RECYCLABLE ITEMS

ALL ITEMS MUST BE EMPTY AND CLEAN

FIBRE AND PAPER

All boxboard must be broken down; that which does not fit in the recycling container must be bundled.

- Books (softcover)
- Boxboard (cereal, tissue boxes, liner removed)
- Calendars, glossy flyers, posters
- Cardboard, cardboard tubes
- Clean paper shopping bags or paper packaging
- Paper egg cartons
- Envelopes, junk mail, newspapers
- Household paper, magazines, catalogues, telephone books

MIXED CONTAINERS

- Empty aerosol cans (empty) (hairspray, cooking spray)
- Aluminum foil, trays, plates (washed and clean)
- Plastic egg cartons
- Cans (steel and aluminum)
- Glass (bottles, jars, jugs)
- Plastic ice cream containers
- Plastic bottles, plastic jars, jugs, bleach bottles, pails, tubs
- Shampoo, conditioner, soap, cleaning bottles
- Windshield washer containers

LARGE ITEM PICK-UP DAYS

PICK-UP DATE REG April 10, 2024 Mai July 17, 2024 Jun October 16, 2024 Sep

REGISTRATION DATE March 5 - April 5 June 12 - July 12

September 11 - October 11

Items must be pre-registered and placed on the curbside before 7:00a.m.

GREEN: COST \$10.00

Items include: Furniture and household items such as lamps, tables, chairs, sofas, dressers, etc

ORANGE: COST \$20.00

Items include: Mattresses and box springs.

BLUE: COST \$15.00

Items include: Stoves, washing machines, dryers, dishwashers, furnaces, hot water tanks, microwaves, sinks, bathtubs, water softeners, water heaters, barbeques, and any items deemed eligible by the Director of Operations.

RED: COST \$65.00

Items include: All Freon supplied household items, such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, de-humidifiers and any other Freon use appliances.

WHITE: COST FREE

Items include: Computers, computer accessories, laptops, monitors, stereos, disk players, fax machines, television, DVD & VCR players, telephones and all other electronic items as deemed eligible by the Director of Operations. Tires and rims (tires must be removed from the rim).







YARD WASTE

Depending on volumes, yard waste collection may extend over multiple days. Yard waste must be placed at the curb in paper bags (plastic not accepted). Weather conditions may affect collection. Municipal compost site is open Tuesday April 16, 2024, through Saturday November 30, 2024 (weather permitting) to Prescott residents only. Passes available to purchase for Commercial Contractors. Site hours include Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and Saturdays 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

TREASURE EXCHANGE DAY

Will occur on Saturday, May 18, 2024. Residents are encouraged to place their surplus items, in good, clean condition, out to the curb **clearly** marked free. Tour the town to find new-to-you treasures!

Will occur January 6-10, 2025. Trees must be free of ornaments, and cut ends placed neatly facing the curb. Artificial trees not collected.
